Greet One Another with a Holy Kiss

What great wisdom from St. Paul! He begins with the desire to greet one another. We are all sisters and brothers and deserve the respect to be greeted as such. But Paul does not stop there. He admonishes this greeting to be a 'holy kiss'. What a great understanding of relationship. We all know a kiss is quite intimate, yet it holds many meanings. Paul distinguishes this kiss as holy. This kiss is not self-serving, not deceitful, not angry, not judgmental, but is a full disclosure of unconditional love and mercy.



This is what the Holy Trinity means to me. Jesus' desire to be one with our creator, with his Father in heaven is so evident in the scripture passages where he went to pray and gain strength and consolation. In gaining intimacy with the disciples, Jesus desired to also be one with them throughout eternity. Through the Father's love, Jesus made the connection to the Holy Spirit that would dwell within and among his disciples forever. All three came together in a 'holy kiss.'

This could be our model for love and community. Jesus' incarnation models for us how we are capable of that same depth of intimacy and relationship with all those we meet. We express this desire through our statement as a parish to 'Love all God's people all the time.' We are called to be as the Trinity. We are equally intertwined. We are integrally in love with each other. We are ever expanding to be inclusive with all we meet.

What more could we ask for to guide our ordinary prayers and thoughts? This is the gift of God's mysterious, yet intimate, presence in our hearts and souls. This gift allows us to 'Greet one another with a holy kiss!'

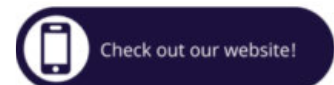

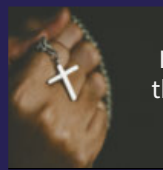
