Rise, and Do Not Be Afraid

The transfiguration is a key moment in the formation of the disciples of Jesus. The disciples saw and heard amazing events and stories that brought them to be in awe of Jesus. They had never met anyone like him. Yet at that moment they were brought up the mountain to view the essence of Jesus fully human and fully divine, their view of Jesus and of life itself were shattered.



My father was an awesome man. As I grew up and saw him run his business, help out around church and our village, and raise us six children with Mom, I was in awe as to how he did it all. Later in his life when he was struggling with cancer and heart problems, another side of him came forth. I saw a man who deeply loved his family. I saw a man who had a deep faith in God and prayer. I saw a man who was deeply generous to so many in our lives. My father's depth was what gave him the strength and energy to shine forth each day of his life. I was so appreciative of that moment when this all came together for me and our family.

True church came to fruition when the disciples made this connection. The human Jesus they encountered many times had a depth to him that came shining forth on that mountain. They were in awe of a man who fully appreciated his humanness. The fullness of creation was present in that moment and in each of Jesus' other moments of encounter. This is important for our understanding Jesus but also in understanding how our faith is present in each encounter we have throughout our days.

What a great image for us to contemplate this summer! Who in your life has shown you the fullness of God? Do you expect the divine to shine forth through your own humanness?

May our lives be transformed into this image of God present here in our midst!

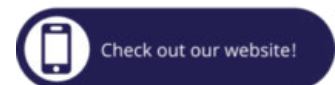
