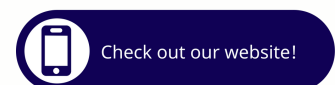

How has the Church implemented these teachings over the centuries?

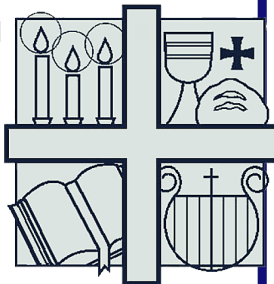
And how do we pastorally journey with those going through the pain of divorce now?

Spiritual Direction

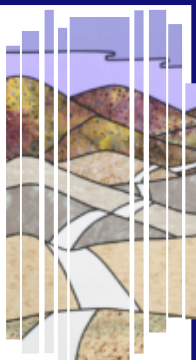
Are you looking for direction for your spiritual journey? Now is an ideal time to re-evaluate your path towards a deeper relationship with God. One way to do that is through Spiritual Direction.

Spiritual Direction is help given by a trained Spiritual Director to another person through confidential, ongoing conversation. It is a relationship between the Director and the one being directed, and at the same time, it is an encounter with God they share in together.

The purpose of the relationship is so the one being directed might grow closer in relationship with God.

The Catholic Foundation of the Green Bay Diocese has provided Resurrection Catholic Parish with a grant to help those wishing to explore spiritual direction to do so free of charge for two introductory sessions.

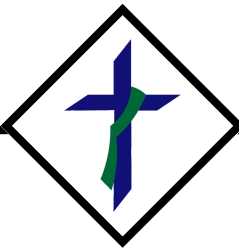
