# Complacent By Deacon Roger Vandervest

When I reflected on today's readings, several words came to mind: oblivious, complacent, celf-centered, arrogant, not caring, and blind to what's around you. The Prophet Amos warns us of the potential consequences of living this way. "Woe to the complacent in Zion." We could reword that quote to say, Woe to the complacent today. The Prophet reminds us that there are consequences for how we live our lives.

Luke's Gospel reading shares a similar message. How oblivious was the rich man? How could he ignore Lazarus sitting by his door? Was he oblivious or just didn't care enough to see Lazarus? Did he see Lazarus as unimportant, not worthy of his time or consideration? Luke was smart by not naming the rich man. By not naming him we can't dismiss his actions as the work of one person. Any of us is capable of acting in some way like the rich man in Luke's story. What do we choose not to see? What are we oblivious to? What is required of us today? Today who is our Lazarus?

The author of today's Psalm, Psalm 146, is very clear on what we are required to do. The Psalmist writes "Blessed is he who... secures justice for the oppressed, gives food to the hungry ...the Lord raises up those who were bowed down. The Lord loves the just; the Lord protects the strangers. The fatherless and the widow he sustains ...."

St. Paul in his letter to Timothy reminds us that Christ is our model in all things. How would Christ respond to Lazarus? How would Christ respond to the needs of our world today? We live in challenging times, but we have guidelines on how to live in challenging times. As St. Paul reminds us, responding to challenges in our lives and community are not easy. We are called to respond to these challenges as Christ would.


