Revealing the Light Within

Earlier this month, my wife JoDee, myself, and a small group of pilgrims explored the Holy Land of Israel and Jordan. It was an experience to walk the ground that Jesus walked. One of the cities we visited was Jericho, which is located on the northeast corner of the Dead Sea. Jericho is the oldest city in civilization. While exploring, our group rode a cable car up the mountain where Jesus, after 40 days in the wilderness, was tempted by the devil. After dinner on the side of the mountain, where we could experience the beautiful views (and temptations), we went down the mountain and toured the town. While in Jericho, we had Mass where we read this weekend's gospel of Jesus's encounter with the tax collector Zacchaeus, who climbed a sycamore tree so he could see Jesus.

The Tree of Zacchaeus, a sycamore, is over 2000 years old and is located at Al-Jummezeh Square in the City Center of Jericho. Tradition has it that this is the tree Zacchaeus climbed when Jesus was passing through the town. In the Gospel of Luke, we hear Jesus saying, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." and "Today salvation has come to this house . . . For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost."

Like the Jesus encounter with Zacchaeus, what are your stories of when someone saw something in you? It may have been your mom or dad who recognized your passion for music or art, for animals or engines, or for anything having to do with a ball. Nudging, not pushing, they encouraged you. They guided you to good help and coaching, quietly sacrificing to give you the resources you needed to develop the talent they saw in you. Through their eyes you came to see what they saw: your passion, your gift, your competence. And you've done them proud. You've made a life for yourself. It may not be a life of wealth and privilege, but it's a life of meaning and purpose, a life in which you've been able to contribute to the good of all. Now it's up to you to help another young "you" realize their passion, their ability, their gift. God works through you.

Go, have fun as you encounter others; **Connect to Inspire, Embrace People's Hearts, Empower to Act, Explore Potential, Nurture Abundant Life & Growth.**

The 5 value statements for encounter were created through a great deal of work from a diocesan Culture Impact Mission Team of which Dcn Kevin was blessed to have been involved. Living these values, we are following Bishop Ricken's vision for the culture we are rising toward as we encounter Christ in one another.

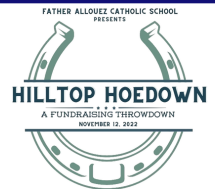
