Resurrection Parish is partnering with Catholic Charities to support efforts at Fort McCoy to welcome and care for Afghan Refugees as we fill a truckload of much needed clothing delivered on October 1st.

Highest need items to be collected - only NEW items can be accepted:

- Clothing: Summer/Fall clothes only, no Winter clothes
 - Men's: unbranded, modest clothing like shirts, pants, socks, shoes, and undergarments in various sizes.
 - Women's: unbranded, modest long-sleeve crew neck shirts, long pants, socks, shoes, and undergarments to remain culturally appropriate in various sizes.
- Children's: mirror the above recommendations in all ages and sizes All items can be dropped off at Resurrection Parish or at Catholic Charities, located at the diocesan offices by 4 PM on September 30th.


