#### **Baptized in Christ**

We are celebrating Sacraments this year as a parish. What is a Sacrament and how do they call us more deeply on our journey toward holiness? A Sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to offer God's grace in our lives. For example, water that cleanses; bread and wine that nourishes; oil that strengthens.

This month of October, we will begin by focusing on Baptism which is the font and initiation into our Christian journey of faith. The world as we know it is still unfolding. As we center on the grace of God revealed in Jesus, we are called to participate more fully toward being the heart, hands, and feet of Jesus fully alive today. This call to holiness for ourselves and the world is central to our Baptismal promises.

What are we promising to do through our Baptism?

- 1. To be an example of Catholic life: With good, personal spiritual practices (prayer) we reach out to family and neighbors in kindness, honesty, and a generous heart.
- 2. To live out the works of mercy: We are only free and in good conscience when all in our world are able to live a dignified and comfortable life.
- 3. To respond to the needs of society: Our concern for our common home (earth) includes good education, just society, quality health care, economic equality, etc. for all.
- 4. To witness our faith to others: If we are to keep all of the above promises, are we willing and able to share that inner seed of faith that has kept us growing and nurtured on our journey? Can we express why we are Catholic a person of faith? Are we comfortable inviting others onto our journey within our church community?

Baptism is an ongoing gift of being called and then surrendering to God's will over and over again, all through our lives. All we do here at Resurrection Parish points to this goal of being Christ in our world today. Thank you for joining us on this journey of over 60 years as Resurrection Parish was 'baptized' into being as a parish!


