


Resurrection Catholic Parish Becoming Disciples of Jesus and Stewards of God's Gifts

The man called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes

There was a woman who was in a very difficult situation within her family. I suggested we talk about her options and what could improve her family situation. She could not hear anything beyond what was in front of her. She chose to stay isolated within her reality.



There was a church community who was getting much feedback from the surrounding society about their beliefs. They refused to listen to the evil society out there and remained isolated from the larger world. They chose to remain ignorant.

I love this story of Jesus and the blind person. We are always in some way 'blind' in that we are constantly being asked to open our eyes and vision to an ever broadening reality and yet we often get tired or angry. Jesus himself was opening up the Jewish faith to a whole new level and they rebuked him to the cross.

Jesus' desire was for all on Earth to be open to all that was of Heaven. He chose clay of the earth and his own saliva which then created an anointing 'on Earth as it is in Heaven'. It seems that what frustrated Jesus the most was when he SAW Heaven right there in front of him and others refused or were unable to open their eyes and hearts. What would have happened if St. Joseph was unable to open his heart to the angel of the Lord?

What are we as church clinging to when we know Jesus opened our eyes to a great way of life? What are you personally holding on to when our prayer is asking us to move beyond our ignorance and pain? What are you and I resisting? Who don't we listen to on a regular basis?




