

Hey Google...Good Shepherd Sunday

I grew up helping my grandpa on the farm. We had cows, pigs, steers, chickens and cats but we did not have sheep. I have had to listen closely to Jesus' example about the sheep and shepherds. In the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, I have learned Jesus was telling us that we are protected and cared for by a loving God through the example of sheep knowing the voice of their shepherd and

As I think about how to pass Jesus' message of voice recognition along to my children and grandchildren, the example they might understand is related to AI (artificial intelligence). They are growing up with so-called smart speakers that rely on voice recognition to respond. Hey Google, (or for others it might be Alexa or Siri), what is the weather going to be like today? Voice recognition focuses on properly identifying the speaker in order to determine who can have access to files, devices, computer systems, and maybe even to secure facilities.

In a sense, today's Gospel is also about voice recognition, authentication and security. Jesus draws a sharp distinction between himself and the Pharisees, contrasting a good shepherd with a hired hand who has no genuine concern for the flock. Jesus insists that the sheep will follow the true shepherd because they recognize their voice, but not the stranger whose voice is unfamiliar.

Hey Google.... Who are today's good shepherds? It's not only bishops and pastors who are called to this task. Parents, grandparents, caregivers, and all those who serve and protect are entrusted with the charge to be good shepherds. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, calls us out to pastures, Res gatherings, small groups, Mass, Outreach...,where our souls will be refreshed and we can Rise Toward Loving All God's People All The Time.


Thank You From the Women's Guild
