

#### Is Not Our Life On Earth a Drudgery?

So often we ourselves or those we love find ourselves in a state of utter misery and weariness. We don't have to go far to experience these feelings of hopelessness in our politics, our economic outlook, our health situation, or our relationship with others. February is a great time to reflect on darkness and depression as we get through another winter season. Yes, spring and hope are on their way.

Our first reading from Job is a great read to help us feel better about our situation. Nobody I know has gone through the loss and hopelessness that Job had to endure. This is a classic example of how it seems all the darkness and misery of life fell upon one character until they are left with nothing from this earthly existence.

I have always prayed that I would not have to be stripped of everything before I become completely open to God's presence. "I am here Lord and grateful for your presence!" Please don't send Satan after me, as you did with Job, to make my life miserable! I surrender and know my place in life. So far so good!

Job learned a great lesson for all of us. Misery and weariness are what we bring onto ourselves. At the end of the Book of Job we find a very different and humbled Job. He said, "By hearsay I had heard of you, but now my eye has seen you. Therefore I disown what I have said, and repent in dust and ashes." This is a new person who discovered their God and their mission on earth. Job was now one with God and neighbor. That brought wholeness and peace. What a great message for us to prepare ourselves for the Lenten season that is very soon upon us.

As Job, may you be rewarded with fourteen thousand sheep instead of seven, six thousand camels instead of three, one thousand yoke of oxen instead of five hundred and a thousand she-donkeys instead of five hundred! What more could we ask for in life!!!
