one by One Campaign

Our Diocese here in Green Bay has reached a transformative decision to initiate a capital campaign called "one by One" - a Catholic campaign designed to transform communities. This \$70 million effort includes calling forth and developing church



leadership, supporting our Catholic Schools and faith formation programs, and each family and individual within our parish/diocese. One half of our parish goal of \$1.4 million will remain in our parish to use as we chose.

Our parish will focus our parish goal of \$700,000 on three areas:

- Creating a Vibrant Parish as engaged as we are, we hired Deacon Kevin DeCleene to direct our efforts to revitalize our parish community. After the Covid experience, we need to re-invite and restructure our fundamental parish ministry structure.
- **Resurrection on Mission** we have always had a strong mission to serve those in need outside of our parish walls. Being good stewards, we strive to reach out and engage others on this mission to Love God and neighbor no matter the situation.
- Upgrade Our Facilities the larger part of our goal of \$700,000 is to update the outside doors, the church organ, the church sound system, the school lockers and an event space under our current parish offices.

Please be open to listening and discussing what this "one by One" Campaign can do for you, our parish and the Diocese of Green Bay. Each layer of our local church is important in keeping our mission of Rising to Love All God's People All The Time.

A special thank you to all of you who have already joined in toward contributing to our goal to reinvigorate church in our local communities. We are well on our way!

Resurrection is one of the 156 parishes in the Diocese to participate in *one by One*. This capital campaign seeks to raise \$70 million for parishes, including ours, while strengthening ministries, Catholic education and faith formation, supporting our clergy and enhancing growth and development across the Diocese.

Resurrection will receive 50% of all funds collected up at the parish level.

During the initial weeks of the campaign, parishioners have already pledged \$452,955 towards this effort! Funds from the campaign will be going towards upgrading our facilities, creating a more vibrant parish through new programs, and developing new initiatives that focus on a mission bigger than just our parish.

What Does Scripture Say About. An Overview of the Bible


Wednesday, September 21 6:30 PM In church or online


