High Five! As we head into the New Year

During a Teens Encounter Christ weekend, I was encouraged by the faith and energy of our high school juniors, seniors, and early college-aged young adults. A visiting priest inspired all with ways to prepare for the new year, sharing 5 simple points that are at hand. He held up his thumb — pointed it upward like a hitchhiker and said, **“prayer.”** The thumb points upward to God, a reminder of our call to daily prayer and the foundation of our faith. The pointer finger — pointing us to **“Mass”** and a chance to be fed by the presence of Christ in others, song, the Word of God, an awesome homily, the Eucharist, and to be sent into the week in peace. The middle finger — kids laughing as he commented on the gesture — is our call to **“reconciliation.”** Whether giving or receiving, this gesture serves as a reminder to go meet with Father. The ring finger — a **“vocational call”** to matrimony, holy orders, or bachelorhood. In all cases, this finger is a symbol of fidelity, commitment, and “service to others.” The pinky finger — a reminder and **“sign of gratitude.”**

As we head into the new year, take a moment and reflect: What is my baptism calling me to do? How rich is my faith? Consider how your hand can help remind you of 5 points to grow in your faith and relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! Pray, Hope, and Don't Worry – St. Padre Pio.

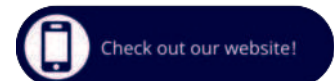

Christmas Lights Collection

The Care for Creation committee would like to thank
everyone who donated Christmas lights—both working and
nonworking—for reusing and recycling! With your help, we
were able to collect 94 strings of nonworking lights, which
have been recycled through Habitat for Humanity Restore,
and 150 strings of working lights, which will be donated to
De Pere Christian Outreach and the Ecumenical Partnership
for Housing next holiday season. At an estimated 15 feet
per string, that's over 3,650 feet of lights—more than 2/3 of a
mile, enough to wrap around the church and school
buildings 2 1/4 times!

Through this collection, we are participating in a circular
economy—a system that keeps resources in circulation for
as long as possible by emphasizing reuse, repair, and
recycling to eliminate waste. Thank you for your support

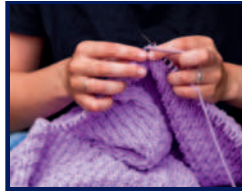
Are you looking for a minimum effort volunteer opportunity?
