Easter People

Twelve years ago we all shouted, "Viva El Papa Francisco!"
Long Live Pope Francis! It was a surprise choice by the
conclave. We are now in the midst of the nine-day mourning
period before the conclave begins to elect a new pope.
It is good to pray and meditate on what we take from
Pope Francis' twelve years of service to our Catholic Church.

As we are in the Easter Season and just celebrated Mercy Sunday last week, I went to Pope Francis' book, entitled *The Church of Mercy*, for inspiration. For me Pope Francis embodied the full mercy of God as he calls us to also embody "the odor of the sheep."

Two aspects of Pope Francis' book remind me of his papacy. The first is how Pope Francis speaks of God's continual call to us toward a deeper relationship with our God. God never turns us away, especially when we smell bad! There is always mercy and hope no matter who we are or what we have done. That is the gift of our loving Creator.

The second is that we were not created to be isolated in bitterness, complaint, or despair. He said, "Jesus, the Good Shepherd, does not humiliate or abandon people to remorse. Our God always restores courage, entrusts responsibility, and sends us out on mission." When we hear of Jesus sending Peter out on mission saying, "Feed my sheep," this is the message of uplifting hope we have been modeling as we love all God's people all the time.

In my time here at Resurrection Parish I have always experienced you as an Easter people. We are not afraid to get smelly as we bring the Good News of our salvation to all of God's creation. This is what sends our parish forward into the future.



from the Care for Creation Committee

Thank you to everyone who supported our Lenten recycling drive, whether you donated your electronics, bikes, glasses, hearing aids, or printer cartridges, volunteered at the April 12 collection event, or simply helped spread the word! We estimate that over 900 cars drove through our parking lot to drop off donations, which ranged from a bag of batteries to a U-Haul full of appliances.

Although we are still waiting on final numbers, here's an overview of what was collected:

- more than 5 semis full of electronics, including 2 semis of TVs and more than half a ton of lead acid batteries
- 77 bikes for Spokes of Hope and St. Vincent De Paul
- 538 pairs of eyeglasses for the Lions Club
- 550+ printer cartridges (both ink and toner) for the Lions Club
- 32 unused printer cartridges and 140+ unused hearing aid batteries for St. Vincent de Paul

These items will either be reused or properly recycled by B3 and our other event partners, the Lions Club and Spokes of Hope, rather than going straight into a landfill.
