### Let the Names Begin:

#### A Lesson in Radical Relationship

Names are important! A few years ago, I received an email from the staff of Mayor Eric Genrich. The mayor wanted to meet with me to discuss StreetLights Outreach, the flagship program of Whatsoever You Do, Inc. For twenty years volunteers of StreetLights Outreach had

provided a positive presence on the streets of Green Bay. The mayor wanted to hear more about the program and stated that he and two of his staff members would attend the meeting with me. Three to one? The power differential didn't seem right to me. So, what did I do? I invited two of our core volunteers, Debbie Ruggles and Melissa Nelson Bohan, to attend the meeting with me to even out the playing field. Why Debbie and Melissa? More than most anyone I know, these two women know the names and stories of our unsheltered brothers and sisters. With their help we could tell the story of StreetLights Outreach with specific names and stories that came out of our experiences. It worked! The mayor was impressed with the activities of StreetLights Outreach and encouraged us to do more.

One of the foundational beliefs of Whatsoever You Do, Inc. in general, and StreetLights Outreach in particular, is that names are important. They establish a relationship between two people, forming the basis of a relationship.

The culture of the people in the Old and New Testament was no different. For them, the knowledge of someone or something's name created a relationship. In the Book of Genesis, when Adam names the various plants and animals, he creates a relationship to all living things. Likewise, he does this with Eve, naming her and creating a relationship between the two of them, starting with their names.

The readings for this Trinity Sunday focus on relationships and the importance of names. In the first reading from Exodus, God lets Moses know that God's name is Lord. Moses uses this name with reverence, creating a relationship between the two. In the Gospel, Jesus says that if people do not believe in his NAME, they will be condemned as there is no relationship between the person and God.

If you are like me, you forget someone's name minutes after meeting them. Yet, at the core of relationship, and at the heart of this Trinity Sunday, is the importance of knowing someone's name. As we now move into Ordinary Time, it remains a challenge for all of us. Let the names begin!

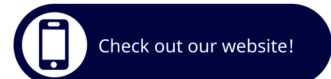

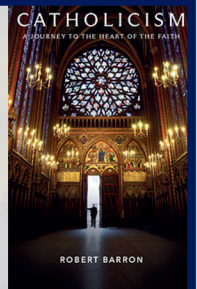
