### To enter God's kingdom, you must become like a child

This is the message of today's gospel.

If creatures from outer space came to earth and asked you to describe what a young child or baby was like, what would you tell them?

You might say that young children are:

**Dependent:** They rely on others to look after their needs and to take care of them.

**Trusting:** They have total trust in their parents and family to care for them and keep them from harm.

**Honest:** They do not know how to lie or deceive. When they are happy and content, they let you know by laughing and smiling; when they are miserable or upset, they let you know by crying loudly.

**Loving:** They return all the love they receive. They enjoy being hugged and cuddled, and feeling secure in their family's love.

**Innocent:** They are pure and free from any wickedness. They have no bad thoughts or unkind feelings.

**Uncomplicated:** Simple things keep them happy and contented — a warm bed, a smiling face, a bottle full of milk.

Jesus once said, "Do not keep the little children away from me! Only those who are like them will enter the kingdom of God." (Matthew 19: 13-15)

None of us stays a child forever. Each of us will grow up to become an adult. Jesus was telling us that he wanted us to keep the childlike qualities of goodness as we become grownups.

Remember some of the features of a small child: trust, honest love, innocence, and simplicity. If we have these qualities, as children of God we will stay close to God's love and never wander from God's friendship.

What did Jesus tell us to do with our cares and troubles? Just as a young child has complete faith and trust in his or her parents, so we can rely on God. We can share our problems and worries and know that we can depend on God to love and take care of us.

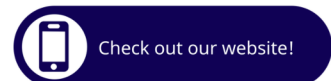
