


## 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time June 22 & 23, 2024



#### **When Storms Arise**

As a kid, I was terrified of storms. The type of terrified where I would take shelter in the basement with a flash of lightning or run to snuggle into my mom's arms with any bang of thunder. Sure, I could play "storm chasers" with my friends and pretend to hunt tornados as they did in the movie "Twister," but to face a real storm was out of the question.



Fast forward to a Saturday night at 16 years old. I was babysitting when a large storm rolled in. I saw the same terror in the youngest child's eyes that I had too many times in my own. I had two choices: be scared *with* her or be strong *for* her. I comforted her and helped her feel secure, knowing that everything would be okay. Soon the storm passed and all was well.

Since that experience, storms don't scare me like they once did.

In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus awakens to the disciples terrified of the storm that overtook their boat. He takes control of the situation and calms the storm. Jesus demonstrated that he has the power over any storm and he is the one who we are to look toward when those storms arise in our lives.

Just like that night of babysitting, I have had to face many different types of storms with two options: fear or faith. I wish I could say I have had faith during every storm I have experienced. But too many times I have allowed fear to prevent me from totally relying on Christ. Too many times I cower away from taking control of the situation. But this Gospel calls me to turn that fear into faith, to grow more mature in my trust in God.

When storms sneak up on us or we see them coming from miles away, we are reassured that God is there. Peace and calmness are present amid the chaos and anxiety. Very often we have no control over the various developments of our society and we have little or no control over what other people do. We can, however, find peace and calmness. God, and those who love us, can comfort and strengthen us to face the storm, as long as we turn to them. Let us all remember to have faith.

#### **Stipend & Stole Fee Update**

The Diocese of Green Bay and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses, funerals, weddings, and Quinceañeras in the past. The donation for these Sacraments and services has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time. The new stipend structure is as follows:

#### Mass Stipend \$20 Funeral Stole Fee \$75 Wedding & Quinceañera Stole Fee \$100

This new fee structure will become effective July 1, 2024. It will not be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1, 2024. As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the Sacrament or service with no fee. Please know that any stipend money collected goes to the parish in support of its ministry and services provided to the parish community; it does not go personally to the priest.
