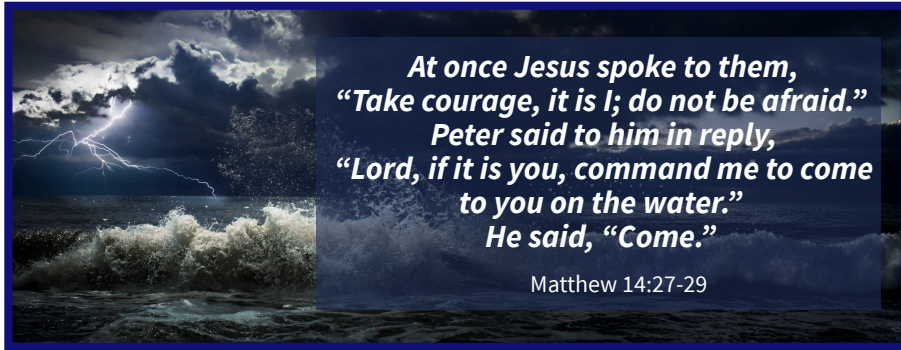

Wind Power

A couple of weeks ago, while we watched the news footage of the F3 tornado that hit the Fox Cities, including our friend and former pastor, Fr. Tom Reynebeau, I couldn't help but remember another wind event that shaped my own life. The date July 15, 1980, is forever stamped in my memory as a day that I discovered the power of wind. My brother and I, teens at the time, were home alone that evening when straight-line winds swept through our hometown of Eau Claire. Prior to that day, I had never heard of straight-line winds. What I quickly discovered is that wind of that type can be more powerful and destructive than a tornado. The airport in Eau Claire measured winds of 120 miles per hour before their instruments broke. When the storm had passed, my brother and I emerged from the basement to discover an entire community that had been affected by the wind's effects. What was once a Tree City U.S.A. now had lumber lying in every street and yard. 97% of the city was left without power. As a family, we were without power for a week and ate our meals at the American Red Cross shelter at North High School. Wind is powerful!

In the first reading this weekend from 1 Kings we have the familiar story of Elijah seeking the presence of God. Elijah doesn't discover God's presence in heavy wind, earthquakes, and fire. Rather, Elijah tangibly encounters the presence of God in a "tiny whispering sound." God is as close to us, if not closer, than we are to ourselves. It doesn't take a movie-like *Twister* experience to discover this reality. It is experienced in quiet — something so difficult to find in our modern, busy, and noisy culture.

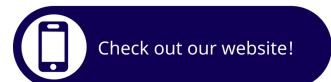

In the Gospel account from St. Matthew, Jesus is spent after feeding the multitude of 5,000-plus people. He seeks the quiet that he knows is where connection with his Father is to be found. While he goes up a mountain for a little personal retreat time, the disciples are being tossed about by the wind on the Sea of Galilee. What a juxtaposition! When Jesus comes down from the mountain and discovers the guys in some nautical trouble, he walks across the water to them. Just as in so many other instances, particularly post-Resurrection appearances, the disciples do not recognize Jesus and think that he is a ghost. Peter, the brave one, strangely requests that Jesus command that he leave the boat and walk on the water with Jesus. Peter begins to sink when he discovers that he has been given the power to walk on water from Jesus but does not fully trust it.

So what about us? Do we take a little time each day or week to quiet ourselves to discover the power of God right within our midst? Do we have courage to get out of the boat, like Peter, to discover the powers that God has given to us? Elijah discovered the presence of God in the tiny, whispering sound. In a world that seems to have an increasing amount of noise, both audible and inaudible, it is a challenge to do the same. But, if we want to walk on water, we need to get out of the boat, discover the power God provides us, and rejoice in the spiritual energy that is available to us. If only we quiet ourselves enough to realize the power in this reality! Wind of the Spirit blow in and through our lives!
