She Lives In Me!

There we were, sitting around the Thanksgiving table, stuffed beyond words with turkey, potatoes, dressing, cranberries, and all the other fixings. No time to stop now! It was time for dessert. Pumpkin pie? Yes! And apple, pecan, lemon meringue, and cherry pie, too. Why have just one pie option when you can have five or six, right?

Was this 1975 or 2025? Was this my mom doing what she always did, providing so much more than was needed? Or was it my older sister, Terri, filling the role of dessert provider after my mom passed away in 2020? The answer—both!

Similarly, when I need to provide snacks for an event or food for a shelter meal, I tend to purchase three times as much as what is necessary. When I'm traveling, I tend to pack twice as many clothes as I will need for the week or weekend.

My mom lives within my siblings and me, that is for sure! Which brings us to this weekend's Gospel from St. John. In what has been entitled "The Last Supper Discourse", Jesus is providing his disciples, and us, with his final instructions before his passion, death, and resurrection. As they are gathered in the upper room, Jesus tells his followers:

The Father will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows him. But you know him, because he remains with you, and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, will remain with us and will be IN us! God will not leave us as orphans but will always be with us through the love of the Spirit. There is nothing more comforting for me than to realize that my mom has not left us as orphans. She is still with me every time I go to the store to shop for a Whatsoever You Do, Inc meal. She is still with us as we gather for family meals and other celebrations. Just like God, she has not left us as orphans but remains with me and IN me.

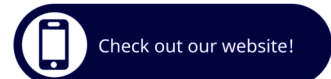

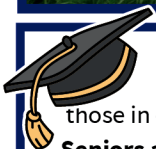

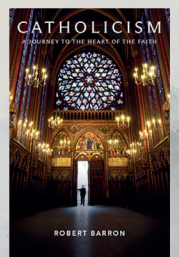
