What joyful event were Jesus and the disciples celebrating at the Last Supper? Every year Jewish families and friends gather to share a meal celebrating the Passover, when they remember how God freed them from slavery in Egypt.

At the Last Supper, Jesus shared a loaf of bread and a cup of wine with his friends. He changed the bread and wine into his own body and blood to nourish them with its life-giving power. Just as our bodies need nourishment to live, so do our souls.

When we come to Mass, we come as one large family to celebrate something that happened for all of us: the resurrection of Jesus. We share a meal together, just as Jesus did at the Last Supper.

What happens when we celebrate Mass together? At our celebration of the Eucharist, which means “thanksgiving”, we remember the meal that Jesus shared with his friends the night before he died; and we share in his death and resurrection. We believe that, through the power of God, the bread and wine become the body and blood of Jesus, who gives himself to each of us in a very special way.

Jesus said, “I am the bread of life,” and when we share in the Eucharistic meal, we share life with the Son of God himself.

It is when the family and the community celebrate together that we share life with the Son of God himself.

Each time you celebrate a meal with your family, you celebrate Eucharist with a small e. Celebrate often and share your celebrations with others. Invite Jesus to the table!

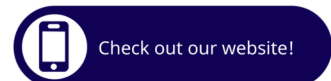
