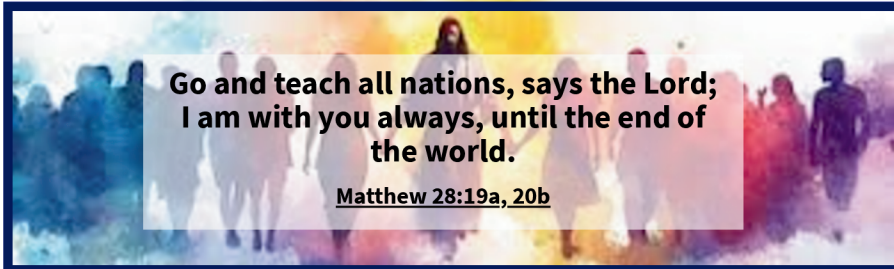

Spring Planting: From Hope to Action

This year, I am creating a small garden at home. I hope to have my 7 grandchildren experience spring planting through fall harvest. From hope to action. We will grow practical plants like beans, lettuce, tomatoes, potatoes, broccoli, and asparagus, and some fun plants like large pumpkins and corn (looking for popcorn). As I am preparing for this fun family activity, I have been thinking about how to weave scripture and the good works of Res Care for Creation into this experience.

In Genesis 2:15, we're told that "The Lord God then took the man and settled him in the garden of Eden, to cultivate and care for it." Have you wondered what God expects of us when he tells us to care for the beautiful creation he has blessed us with? Pope Francis helps answer this question in his 2015 Encyclical, *Laudato Si'*, On Care for Our Common Home. In his letter, Pope Francis talks about the challenges facing us, problems that go beyond the changes we're seeing in our climate, which include a decline in the quality of human life, a breakdown in society, and global inequality. In his letter, he appeals to us for a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet.

May 17 marks the beginning of *Laudato Si'* Week, in which we focus on how we can honor and protect God's creation. The theme of *Laudato Si'* Week this year is "From Hope to Action." Consider joining one of the Res discussion sessions that will cover the roots of *Laudato Si'* on Tuesday, May 19. This will be an engaging event where you can learn more about what caring for our common home entails and what we can do as a Parish and as individuals to convert hope for the future of God's creation into action. You can attend Tuesday morning, 8:45 to 10:00 AM in the Gathering Area, or Tuesday at 6:30 to 8:00 PM in the meeting rooms in the Parish office area. Light refreshments will be served. And stay tuned for how the grandchildren's garden experience plays out.

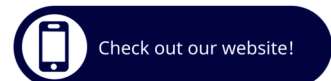

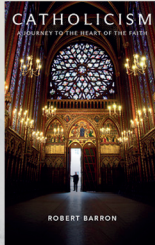
