## **Revealed Through the Little Ones**

Recently Whatsoever You Do, Inc. sponsored a StreetLights Outreach Block Party in Seymour Park. It was a typical summer evening in an at-risk neighborhood, with people strolling toward the park to enjoy a hamburger or hotdog and a cold soda or

water, all while listening to some great music by *Back When Memories*. What made this particular Block Party different were two things: Rachel Warpinski was lending her incredible gift as a professional face painter to the operation; and the number of children present nearly exceeded the number of adults.

When our two adult children were younger, face painting for them meant a small flower, unicorn, or bee on a cheek. With Rachel, the children BECAME the lion, or butterfly, or cat. It was a sight to behold. The line of children lasted an hour past closing time!

But what really struck me about the evening was a story by Rachel's father, Jim Warpinski, who, along with his wife Diane, are newer parishioners at Resurrection and first-time attendees of a StreetLights Outreach Block Party. Jim described how his two grandchildren, who were along for the ride to help Rachel with the face painting, actually became "just one of the gang" with the other kids, playing on the swings and running around like kids do. At the end of the night, the children said good-bye as if they were longtime friends.

This reminded me of today's Gospel reading. Jesus is praying to his heavenly Father with these words: "I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned you have revealed them to little ones." How we are to be in relation with one another, treating each other as equals, each created in the image and likeness of God—that is what the children in the park were revealing to us.

Which brings me to my last point. In the recently released parish podcast, *Auditio Divina*, Katie and I explore the song "Dance With Everybody." In the song, Drew Holcomb and the Neighbors and The National Parks describe putting aside our differences, narrowing the distance between us, and meeting each other in the middle. The children in Seymour Park revealed this to all of us. In our striving to Love All God's People All the Time, it is the children, the little ones, who most naturally reveal this gift of love and acceptance from God.
