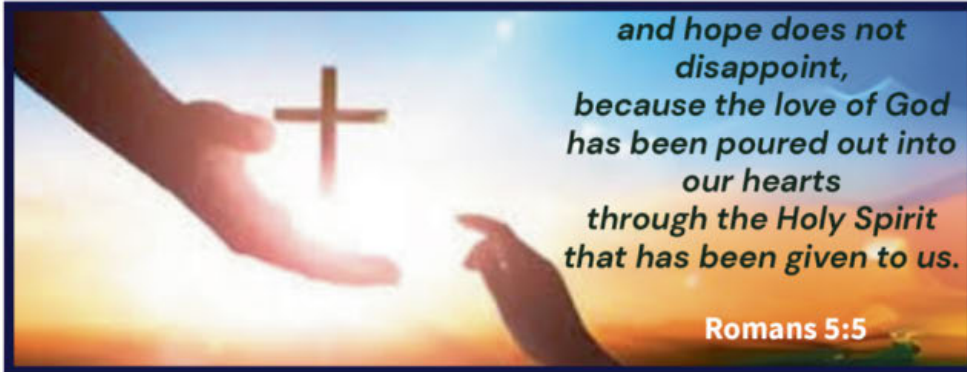

Trinity – Time To Enter Mystery

Further reflection on my journey to Greece in the footsteps of St. Paul has me admiring Paul's gift to accept the reality of the moment. He got kicked out of another town, yet held on to the possibility that God's Spirit would move hearts in the future, thus forming the Christian community. Paul had to hold on to his hope in the expression "already-but-not-yet." He was able to hold the moment as Spirit-filled and yet know that God had so much more planned for the situation. This was a reminder to him, and us today, that we can bring what we have to any moment, but ultimately God's vision is so far beyond ours.



I recently found another way of helping us relate to the mystery of the Trinity. Time as we know it consists of the past, present, and future. Each moment of our day has an element of each. Imagine visiting a friend. You have a past relationship with them that you bring to that moment. The present moment is not controlled by the past and is open to what is present in the moment of your visit. Where this visit takes you in the future brings together the past and present, yet is not limited to either. Each moment of our lives has all three dimensions that affirm who we are and offers to define who we are to become.

St. Paul describes this continual movement through a journey as he "boasts" of affliction. He states, "affliction produces endurance, endurance produces proven character, proven character produces hope that does not disappoint" because of the Holy Spirit poured into our hearts. Spirit always builds upon Spirit. Each moment always builds upon another moment.

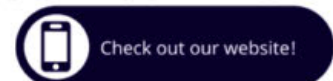
