

Journeying Together as the Body of Christ

There I was, ready to take my final theology class during my senior year at St. John's University in Collegeville, MN.

The professor was scheduled to be the highly esteemed Fr. Godfrey Diekman, OSB, the theologian from the United States most associated with providing the thoughts on the liturgical changes that were discussed at Vatican II and then



implemented in the years that followed. He truly was one of the fathers of the Liturgical Renewal that emanated from St. John's Abbey and formed the changes that would change the world. Yet, there was one problem. Fr. Godfrey became ill. He could no longer teach us about patristics, the work and writings of the early Church Fathers and Mothers — the writings that influenced the thoughts of the bishops gathered in Rome from 1962-1965. I was bummed! There would be no other chances. I would graduate in the spring.

But I have read books on Fr. Godfrey and his predecessor, Fr. Virgil Michael, OSB. Both men helped the Church to view the Eucharist differently. No longer was participating in Mass a private, devotional experience. With their hard work and brilliant writing and speaking, the Vatican Council fathers came to see the Eucharist as very much tied to the activities of social justice. We receive the Body of Christ so that we can become the Body of Christ that transforms this broken world in need of healing.

This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. We celebrate that when we gather as a community, we bring all we have done and all we have been as the People of God this past week to the summit of our faith. Then, having been nourished by the Word, by the Body and Blood of Christ, and by each other, we find the sustenance needed to have this Holy Communion be the source for our activities to renew our world this coming week. The source and summit of our faith is how Vatican II viewed this prayer that we engage in weekly, and, for some, daily.




