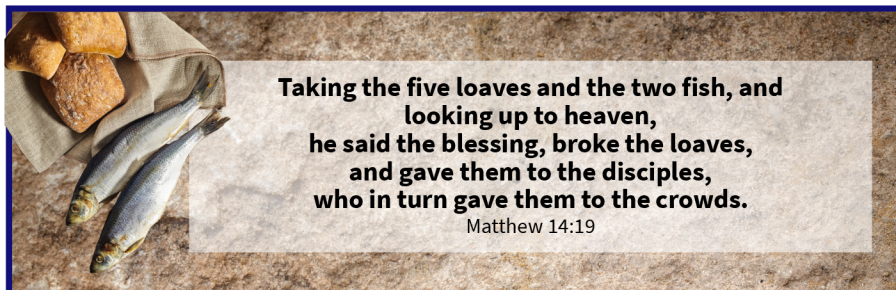

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday's gospel of Jesus feeding the 5,000 is a familiar and favorite for many believers. The particular version from St. Matthew's Gospel begins with Jesus having just heard of the brutal and senseless beheading of his cousin, John the Baptist. We are told that Jesus needed to get away from everyone, be alone to grieve. Yet when the crowds found him "his heart was moved with pity for them."

Life is like that, isn't it. I can't count the number of times I've visited with someone facing a difficult challenge who will say to me "but others have it worse." Then they offer a helping hand with their prayers, or a card, or very often a meal. Feeding others with concern, compassion and understanding is a gospel mandate that is often seen in those who themselves are hurting.

It's notable in this miracle story that Jesus doesn't feed the people all by himself. Rather, he tells his disciples, "give them some food yourselves." I wonder if they rolled their eyes, shook their heads, and muttered as I often do when a task seems impossible. So Jesus does with them as he does with each of us, He shows the way. Together they feed the crowds. Or maybe as some commentators suggest, the crowds shared what little they may have had in their backpacks. Having been so grateful for the healing words and actions of Jesus, they were moved to help those around them. Perhaps sharing with others so no one goes hungry was (and is) the real miracle.

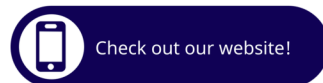

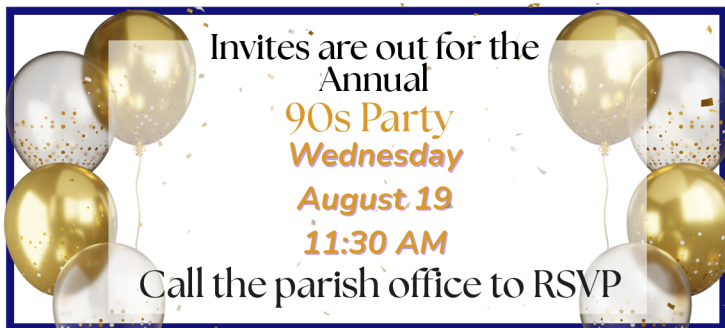

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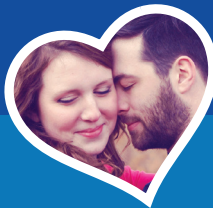
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
