...A Good and Meaningful Life

As my mother turned 96 last month, she has shared with us a common question over the past few years. After she had to give up knitting, sewing, and especially her car because of her failing eyesight, she has frequently questioned what her 'good and meaningful life' entailed without all of that to fill her time. We encourage her by reminding her of the many ways she is still very supportive and prayerful of her family. Yet she struggles at times to find meaning.



In our readings this weekend, Isaiah used practical examples to describe a meaningful life. How we treat each other, help out those who are in need and stay in good communication with our divine/eternal God. Paul begins with his inner weakness and fear as this then allows him to authentically live out his faith in Jesus Christ. Jesus, in the sermon on the Mount, speaks from 'above' recognizing the 'salty' flavor of life that comes through our words and actions to bring 'spice' to the world. As the 'light of the world' we have the capacity to mitigate suffering in our world as we strive to bring a societal transformation that reflects the Kingdom of God.

We have much to do to grow toward becoming a more authentic Christian Community. We have a responsibility to live our faith in such a way that it not only fills our own needs but also the needs of ALL God's creation. This is our message that is guiding us at Resurrection Parish today; WE STRIVE TO LOVE ALL GOD'S PEOPLE ALL THE TIME. There is no escaping this mission of love and compassion that is capable of transforming our world today.

Be the love, justice and peace that our world needs so badly today to find good and meaningful life. What goals do you have to bring your life toward being a greater beacon of light and hope in our world today?

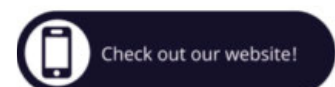

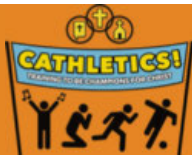

In addition to training resources, Resurrection will gather to walk and pray as a group every

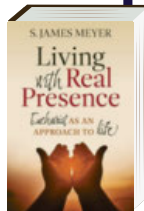
