Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi (Prayer for Peace) Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy. O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

What is a Deacon?

Every now and then, as I greet people after Mass, someone will say to me: "Good morning, Father." It's a reasonable mistake – I am usually wearing clothes that look like what the priest wears. But a permanent deacon is not a priest. So what is a permanent deacon?

A permanent deacon is a male person who begins the path to being a deacon between the ages of 30 and 55, and who has a calling to serve other people. Like the original deacons described in the New Testament's Book of Acts, the deacon's main role is to serve other people in various roles such as preacher, catechist, chaplain, faith formation teacher, parish director, and a deacon at the Mass. In order to become a deacon, a man must be of a certain age, have completed the training required by the diocese, and be ordained by the Bishop.

There are two types of deacons: a transitional deacon (this is a stage on the path to priesthood) and a permanent deacon, who may be married. If the permanent deacon is married, he may not remarry if his spouse dies. That is because he takes a delayed vow of celibacy.

There are three orders of clergy in the Catholic Church: the Episcopate (a bishop), the presbyterate (a priest), and the diaconate (a deacon). All three are considered clergy. All three have some functions (called "faculties") in common and some unique to that order.
