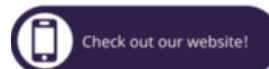

Happy Earth Day – Today & Every Day

As we make note of the international celebration of Earth Day this weekend, those of us of a “certain age” may have memories of the first official nation-wide Earth Day; some of us may have even participated in those very early efforts. The late Wisconsin State Senator Gaylord Nelson is credited with the institution of Earth Day in our country back in 1970.



As People of God, we acknowledge God’s call to care for all of life and the universe as one of the key themes found in the two Creation stories featured in the Book of Genesis.

We must also never forget the debt we owe to the Indigenous Peoples as stewards dedicated to caring for Creation, long recognizing all life is intertwined and dependent on well-ordered, balanced ecosystems. The First Nations continue to protect the land and its resources; their ongoing leadership and contributions to protecting all of Creation should be a model to us all.

Care and respect for Creation was one of our late Pope Benedict XVI’s reoccurring themes; he often addressed the connection between human dignity, peace & justice with the fair, equitable sharing and protection of natural resources. His emphasis on such topics earned him the nickname “The Green Pope” and he is credited with laying the ground work for Pope Francis’ second Encyclical Letter we know as Laudato si’ - Care For Our Common Home.

This Encyclical written by Pope Francis in 2015 reminds us to never forget “everything is connected” ... the way we treat the Earth is a reflection of how we treat each other. Caring for each other, respecting all life, loving all God’s people, means respecting, honoring, and protecting the world we share, which Scripture calls us to protect for future generations.

Consider taking some time to read the Laudato si’ document. You can find it on the Vatican’s website. Numerous Catholic organizations are working on the varied initiatives called for within this Encyclical. There are a myriad of opportunities designed to help you deepen your commitment as one of God’s stewards of Creation as an individual, for your household of faith, your schools, workplaces, communities, as well as our parish. Care for our environment is one of the markers of our faith, truly core to our identity. As a person of faith, in what new and different ways can you add to your faith-based commitment to protecting God’s creation, not only on Earth Day but every day?
