
Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit.

The Cinderella of the Holy Trinity

"The church needs a more developed pneumatology."

Huh? The church needs better lungs?



Ah! So that's what pneumatology is: the theological study of the Holy Spirit.

Fancy words for a simple idea. It calls us to be aware of, and listen to, the Holy Spirit more. The third person of the Trinity cannot be the "Cinderella of Theology," as Dutch theologian George Johan Sirks wrote in 1957's Harvard Theological Review. He observed that the Holy Spirit is like Cinderella before meeting Prince Charming, being overlooked and ignored in comparison to the stepsisters of God the Creator and Jesus Christ. Wouldn't you love to see Disney produce that version!

The Holy Spirit is alive and actively participating in our daily lives. We must recognize the forward movement of the Holy Spirit to a full extent and not get in the way. Do we listen and act to where the Holy Spirit is calling us? Sometimes we look so much to the past that we do not allow the movement of the Spirit to propel us forward. In those instances, we miss how the Holy Spirit calls us to go out and spread the Gospel of love.






<u>Taizé Prayer</u>
