


Second Sunday of Lent March 5, 2023



'This is my beloved, with whom I am well pleased.'

Dcn. Steve Meyer in his book, "Living with Real Presence - Eucharist as an approach to Life," speaks of listening to some very troubling stories from those living on the streets of Green Bay. Steve often finds the 'transfiguration moment' alive and well within unhoused persons that then illuminates the real presence of Jesus in his own heart.



As Steve is listening to them, he relates in his book, "I learned on the streets that I have no right to judge another person. I don't know what floggings, thorns, and crosses they've borne. I don't know what price they've paid for the sins of others, what traumas they've had imposed upon them. But when they've allowed me to touch their wounds, I've been blessed to reach into their brokenness. This is where the risen Christ lives!" I am excited to hear more from Dcn. Steve at our parish mission here at Resurrection Parish, March 13 and 14 at 6:30 PM.

For me, the transfiguration of Jesus, when Jesus is transparent in who he truly is, in the fullness of God, demonstrates how we can love all God's people all the time. My greatest joys in life have been in situations when I have encountered the inner sacred depth of another or that another has encountered the inner sacred depth within myself. When we can encounter each other in this fullness at the same time, in the same moment, we have just discovered once again the fullness of heaven on earth. What joy and peace!

Lent is an opportunity to align ourselves, once again, with this vision of God looking down upon us and rejoicing in each of us as God's beloved. Encountering Jesus within the Eucharist is the real presence of God within our lives. May our Lenten prayer and actions lead us even deeper into to our Baptismal call to service; into loving all God's people all the time.

Come to listen, share, be changed.


