## The Process of Advent

John the Baptist reminds us that life is a process. John saw his mission to preach the kingdom of God that led us toward the coming of the messiah. For John and for us, this journey is ever unfolding. That brings me hope and joy!



So often we get stuck in what worked yesterday but does not today. The inner values are the same and yet our daily lives are certainly different than that of our grandparents.

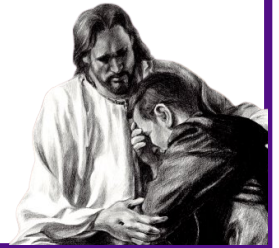
