


First Sunday of Advent November 29 & 30, 2025



Advent: A Season of Hope and Renewal

Today we begin our Advent journey. We also begin a new Liturgical Year. We'll spend the year with Matthew's Gospel. Matthew's Gospel is often considered the most Jewish of the four Gospels. Written primarily for a Jewish audience, it seeks to demonstrate that Jesus is the fulfillment of the Old Testament and to encourage Jewish believers to recognize Him as the Messiah. Matthew frequently quotes the Old Testament, more than any other Gospel, in order to help his Jewish audience come to believe Jesus is the Messiah.

There are many unique terms and stories in this Gospel. Matthew uses the term "Kingdom of Heaven", a phrase not found in the other Gospels. This reflects Matthew's Jewish audience and emphasizes the spiritual reign of God. The genealogy in Matthew, one of my favorite Gospels to read, traces Jesus' lineage back to Abraham, emphasizing His Jewish heritage and fulfillment of God's Promise to Israel.

We'll listen to several miracle stories and parables unique to Matthew, such as the parable of the weeds and the parable of the lost sheep. We'll also hear unique details about the birth of Jesus, the visit of the Magi, and the flight into Egypt. This Gospel contains some of the most complete versions of Jesus' teachings, including the Sermon on the Mount, which encompasses the beatitudes and ethical teachings that are foundational to Discipleship.

If we listen throughout this Liturgical Year, we will hear all we need to become and continue to be good disciples. We begin our journey with Matthew's reminder to be aware and alert. We don't know when the Second Coming will happen. We also don't know when our time on earth will end. Not something most people want to think too much about. It is however a reality. We can't avoid it. We are reminded each year at the beginning of Advent to be ready. It is our first Christmas gift.





Valet attendants are needed to park and retrieve cars. They must be 25 years old or older. Contact the Parish Office to help.




Tree of Giving
