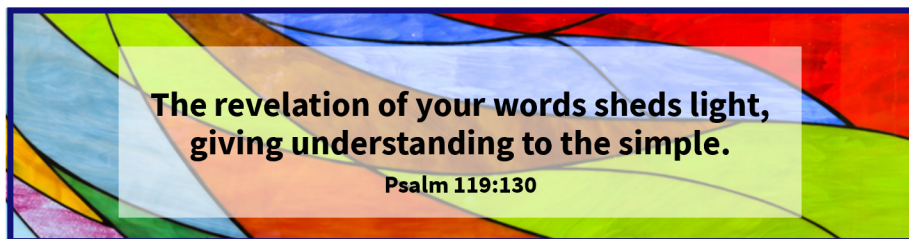

### APPRECIATION

An article in a newspaper described a 30-year-old woman who, during the pandemic, had taken to going through her closets. Referring to a particular 16-year-old Snoopy T-shirt, the author reflected on being young and idealistic.

As I read, I remembered pieces of my high school years. Like others my age, I was idealistic, naïve, full of energy — and full of myself. I was unaware of my immaturity and lack of some important virtues. Now over 60 years later, one (among others) comes to mind: I lacked **appreciation**.

To truly appreciate something or someone, we need a healthy sense of perspective and an internal measuring stick that tells us someone has done a good thing for us. It doesn't have to be spectacular, but it is a blessing to experience it.

Experiencing the Holy Spirit acting in our lives is one of these blessings. However, in order to experience the Spirit, we must learn to be vulnerable and to realize that in some setbacks there will be a later benefit.

Now I can appreciate the suffering other people go through. The older one gets, the more opportunities for such appreciation. Now I can appreciate the beauty of a balmy summer day, and the countless times God has saved me from my own foolishness. Now I can appreciate that others are nicer, smarter, or stronger than I am, and hope they will use those God-given talents for the good of others.

To truly appreciate someone or something is to have a heightened sense of the positive effect this event had. Appreciating the moment takes us, temporarily, out of self-preoccupation and helps us to realize how much of our lives is a gift — the grace of being a human being alive in God's creation.
