Nurturing the Lenten Practices in Your Household of Faith

Lent is a great time to work on deepening our Catholic Identity within our households of faith. In addition to the Lenten practices and traditions already honored, the forty days of Lent provide us with an extended time to try new and different experiences in our efforts to ready our hearts and minds for Easter.



During Lent, we are called to refocus our practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These forty days are dedicated to "upping our game" as disciples of Christ. Consider trying a new style of prayer. Try fasting or abstaining in a different way. Commit additional time or financial support to an agency serving the poor. Open your heart to learning about issues people struggling on the margins face and work towards bringing about change.

I set aside some time every year before Lent to talk with my children and grandchildren – our annual pre-Lenten talk. As they grow and mature, I want to encourage them to consider the differences between fasting and abstaining, and the purpose of fasting. I don't want them to lose focus on their relationship with God, the call to love our neighbors, and to care for those living on the margins in our world. We talk about how easy it is to reduce Lenten fasting/abstaining to acts of "giving up" chocolate, TikTok, or other less than desirable behavior, which has limited impact on anyone but ourselves. The Lenten call to solidarity with those living with less, the collective nature of our shared efforts to build God's Kingdom here on earth, our relationship with the body of Christ all suffers a bit of a disconnect when one fasts or abstains in this self-focused way.

If you don't already use the Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl project in your home, consider checking it out this Lent. The meatless recipes they provide will not only help you abstain from meat but will lessen the impact on our environment as plant-based meals lessen the overall level of emissions. The simple at-home suggestions for almsgiving will lead to deeper conversations around the inequities in our world. The short videos found on their web site to learn about daily life in different countries in some of the poorest regions of the world; an opportunity to nurture empathy, understanding, and global awareness.





Looking for a great way to kick-start your relationship with Jesus as well as begin the Lenten journey? Consider Be Like Jesus/Live Like Jesus.


