



Twenty-First Weekend in Ordinary Time August 20 & 21, 2022



"I do not know where you are from."

Are you holy? Do you follow in the fullness of Jesus' love and command? Is unconditional love even on your radar? I would suggest the answer is exactly the same for each of us: we are all somewhere along the path of salvation. Our individual response depends on how far along and how close to the middle we are treading on that path.



Our gospel today is asking the question, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Jesus' response is that the path is narrow and difficult to navigate. This seems discouraging at best and yes, to some Jesus will respond, "I do not know where you are from." Yet, I believe that the true measure of Jesus' response is not about the destination but the intention we hold to remaining on the path. Jesus is always ready to open the door for us – will we be recognized as a true believer?

This autumn brings more opportunities to fall in line with the presence of Jesus. Our life-long learning focus this year will be on Scripture. How amazing is it that we can walk with Jesus through so many stories which will lead us into a deeper journey with our God and our neighbors? As we open our hearts and souls to Jesus' presence our lives are transformed into the very presence of Jesus – that is salvation!

Great beginning to our daily prayer: let me not be concerned as to whether I am saved but how am I allowing God's presence to save and transform me this day? That is good prayer and stewardship.


