#### **Bubbles Up**

Breath — the very essence of life. From the beginning, God blew the breath of life into us and thus we became living beings. At our birth, we breathe our first breath and continue breathing until that final moment of our earthly life. Many times, we take our breathing for granted and don't think about it, until it becomes a struggle.



Stress and illness can interrupt our ability to breathe. Whether it's caused by something minor like having the wind knocked out of one's lungs, or something more serious like COPD, it's a feeling most of us don't want to experience often. For many of us, stress can cause our breathing patterns to change. That is why it is important to pay attention to our breath when we become stressed, need relaxation, or lose focus.

As Jesus hung on the cross, he struggled to breathe. He knew the physical and mental pain of gasping for air. Before his death, Jesus gave a loud cry and breathed his last. Medically, he died from cardiac and respiratory arrest, but spiritually he gave his very essence to us. He gave his dying breath so that we may live. And yet, was it really the last breath of Christ? No! Death is not the end. Christ's breath continues to give us life, if we breathe it in.

What do we do when we struggle for breath, either physically or spiritually? It's simple! Just inhale through your nose and exhale through your mouth slowly. As you inhale, focus on a word that represents what you ask of God and as you exhale, let go of a word that represents what you are struggling with. Repeat.

Tony and I have been reflecting on the Lenten Gospels through songs on our *Auditio Divina* podcast. For this weekend's Gospel for Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we chose the song "Bubbles Up" by Jimmy Buffet. This was Jimmy Buffet's last gift of song. It's a hopeful tune that encourages us to keep looking for the light, especially the light and love of God. The lyrics of the song remind us that when we are lost, we just need to breathe and follow the bubbles up. It's by following the bubbles up that we find salvation and peace. As we reflect on the Passion of Jesus this weekend, let us unite with Jesus and each other in the pain that we endure on our faith journey. But also let us remember that beyond our breath is the glory of the Resurrection and the love of God.





# The Big Read: A Spring Book Discussion Opportunity

Responses will be compiled and sent to the General Secretariat of the Synod in Rome.




