Are you the King of the Jews?

Pilate questions Jesus as he tries to discern what crime Jesus may have committed to be brought before him. The only challenge is to whether Jesus may be a king which would be problematic in relationship to the Emperor. There can only be one ruler! We can only follow one truth. Truth is eternal. Truth gives direction. Truth brings us together in a fair and just manner.



As Jesus describes his kingdom it is through metaphors of a mustard seed, a treasure hidden in a field or of the finest pearl for which we sell everything. It is this inner desire, faith, hope and prayer that feeds Jesus' universal call to oneness. Jesus desired freedom for all he met. In the kingdom of God, people trust the widowed mothers and beggars to explain how the financial system really works. This same kingdom looks to migrants and refugees to understand the true character of nations; the wounded and outcast help to understand true religion. No wonder Pilate was confused!

We too are often confused today when we try to understand what Jesus is asking of us as we build the Kingdom of God; as we build the Body of Christ. Our natural instinct is to follow our own truth and yet eternal truth is so much more encompassing and inclusive. So often we discover other 'kings' to follow, other truths in which to believe.

This feast of Christ the King reminds us that we are called through our baptism to be true to our faith in Jesus Christ. A truth that is counter-intuitive, that is mind boggling and yet sets us free. A truth that is eternal.

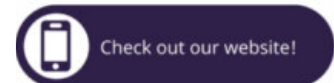

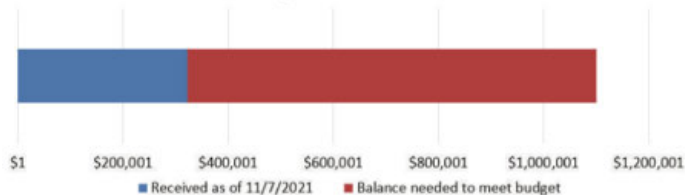

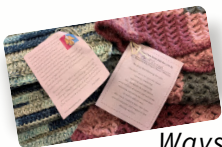
