

God's Desire for Israel

These past weeks our first reading has been from the book of Exodus which speaks of God leading the people of Israel out of slavery in Egypt to the promised land. This is the epic story of the Hebrew Scriptures, the Old Testament. All of salvation history, from the beginning of time, through



the time of Jesus, to our time today, is centered on God's actions that transforms the lives of those who believe. We have an active God who gifts us with what we need to live eternal lives.

Jesus brings out a key aspect of this graciousness of God. Jesus calls the disciples and then forms them to go out to preach and teach the goodness of God: 'Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons.' The Word of God is key to spreading the message of hope, and yet without actions, the words lose their effectiveness to transform lives. We know that it is in word and deed that lives are changed.

Resurrection Parish has been living this message for the past 60 years. Our outreach to those who are sick, to those who have lost hope and to those struggling with many forms of demons has been very clearly laid out. We preach and then we do! Res is instrumental in the area of housing, homeless shelters, health practices, immigration and prison reform and so many other ways when our words became actions.

Last weekend we had a Eucharistic procession that ended with a number of us helping out at a food pantry in their efforts to feed the poor. Prayer led to action! This is exactly what Jesus formed the disciples to do and be in their lives. What joy we experience as a parish when we can declare our commitment to walk always in the ways of Jesus.

Thank you Resurrection Parish for this strong level of commitment to Jesus' ministry here in the Green Bay area! God's desire for Israel is also God's desire of us today.
