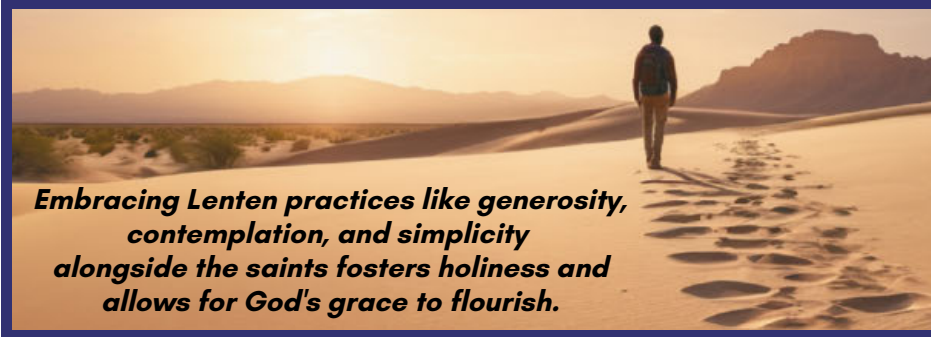

Turning toward Moments of Grace

This great door into our Lenten season, authored by our own Katie McAllister, directs our hearts and minds toward a spiritual journey that brings us alongside Jesus’ life, suffering, death and eventual resurrection. This is the Good News!!!

Each week we will emphasize two saintly people who have lived their lives in a way that brought them closer to God. They each had moments of decision, a happenstance that changed their lives drastically. There was great fear and anxiety they had to pass through in order to welcome God’s love and be gently prodded to break free from their obstacles and discover the freedom of God’s presence. Lent is not an end – but a journey toward resurrection!

To guide us on this journey of faith, we have invited **Fr. Ed Shea**, a Franciscan priest from Chicago, to present a Lenten Parish Mission: **How Great Thou Art: Celebrating Moments of Grace**. Fr. Ed is a dynamic speaker who loves to sing and share stories that bring his audience to a fresh understanding of our faith and church community. Join Fr. Ed at all Masses this weekend as well as this Sunday evening at 6:30pm, Monday at 8:45am or 6:30pm, and Tuesday at 8:45am or 6:30pm. Our hearts and souls will be enriched by this Moment of Grace as God leads us through the desert into the resurrection of hope and salvation.

May this Lenten season transform our inner souls and our parish community into a deeper sense of purpose and mission.

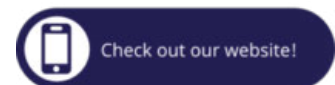

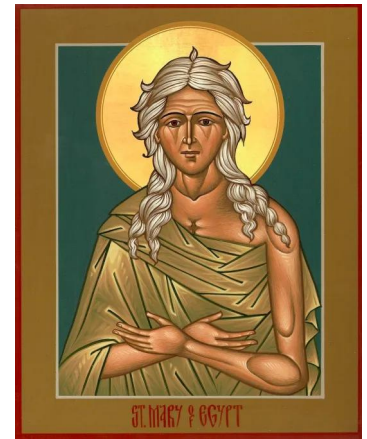
St. Mary of Egypt – 4th century

“Allow me to see the venerable Tree on which He Who was born of thee suffered in the flesh and on which He shed His holy Blood for the redemption of sinners and for me, unworthy as I am.”

St. Mary of Egypt is known for her conversion and dedication of her life to God. Many people see her as a model of repentance. Her life exemplified a woman at that time not being able to financially support herself, or what today we may refer to as sex trafficking or a sexual addiction that took over her life.

Mary struggled for 17 years. Her shame and guilt caught up with her. She had a moment of grace below a statue of Mary, Mother of Jesus. This moment brought her to tears and repentance.

Mary then discerned her life, which led her to cross the Jordan River and head into the desert toward Arabia. There she remained until she died.



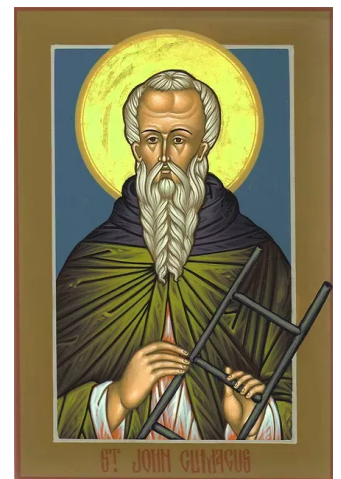
**St. Mary of Egypt inspire us during the Resurrection Steps of our Lenten journey to know that God is merciful and kind, always ready to forgive us as we say, “Lord, I am not worthy to receive you....”
Fill us with the grace of your Real Presence.**

St. John Climacus (c. 579-649) – The Ladder of Divine Ascent.

“Prayer is the mother and daughter of tears. It is an expiation of sin, a bridge across temptation, a bulwark against affliction. It wipes out conflict, is the work of angels, and is the nourishment of everything spiritual.”

St. John Climacus, at the age of 16, went to live in a hermitage in a life of prayer as he studied scripture and the early church writers for many years. Toward the end of his life John’s Moment of Grace was envisioning a “step ladder” of attitudes and practices that would lead a person toward eternal life here on earth as is in heaven. When we pray, we step into the world of spirituality which defines, sustains, nourishes, and gives our lives meaning, direction, purpose, and fulfilment as a child of God.

While prayer may not save us, we will become worthy of being saved. When we pray, we have a state of mind that sees God in everything which is evidence that we have grown in grace and with a thankful heart. May our souls and lives be led by God’s Spirit into Easter hope and salvation.

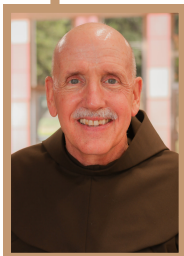

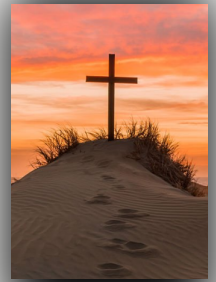

All are welcome, regardless of May 6th participation.

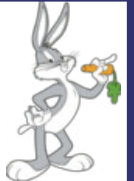
