


### Thirty-Third Weekend in Ordinary Time November 12 & 13, 2022



#### **Another Year Has Come and Gone**

As some of you know, my favorite holiday of the year is Halloween—for lots of reasons! An annual tradition that I enjoy is watching It's the Great Pumpkin, Charlie Brown which came out when I was three years old in 1966. At the end of the holiday classic, Charlie Brown turns to Linus and says: "Well, another Halloween has come and gone."



Another election season has come and gone as well. No more commercials on TV and the radio (at least for a month!) No more texts and phone calls from unfamiliar numbers. No more stress at the rising political tension and division that has torn at the fabric of our community and country.

In the first reading for this weekend, the prophet Malachi reminds the Israelites that "there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays." Healing. That is what our community and country need. That is what we all need.

St. Paul alludes to the divisions in the community at Thessalonica when he writes his Second Letter to the Thessalonians. He says: "We hear that some are conducting themselves among you in a disorderly way, by not keeping busy but minding the business of others." There were divisions 2,000 years ago in the Christian community in need of "the healing rays of justice" as it is today.

Finally, Jesus notes the division that is going to happen as the world comes to an end. He states: "You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed." Knowing that some of us have a little more hair to lose than others (some are trying to compensate with the No Shave November!), these words are both comforting and a challenge.

In the end, we are not Republican vs. Democrats. We are not Liberals vs. Conservatives. We are believers in the one who came to bring "the sun of justice with its healing rays." The Son of Justice leads us to be sons and daughters of justice, peace, unity and love. As we begin a new Church Year in the coming weeks with Advent, we strive again to make it so.

You may write an uplifting message and put your favorite Scripture quote in the card if you like.



# The Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA Triannual National Collection

Every three years, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops authorize a nationwide collection on or near Veterans' Day in November for the Roman Catholic Archdiocese for the Military Services (AMS).

The AMS relies solely on private donors in support of its mission "serving those who serve" and its ministry to provide the same pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in all six branches of the US Armed Forces, enrolled in Military Academies, or undergoing treatment at any of the VA Medical Centers.

Fr. Michael Dory and Fr. Matt Faucett of the Diocese of Green Bay currently serve in the AMS as active chaplains; Fr. Patrick Costello is scheduled for active duty in 2024.
