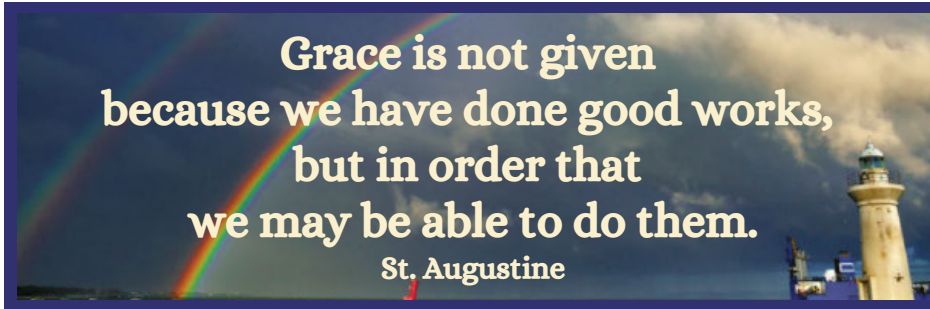

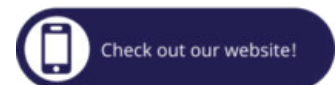

collect snacks for Tank and Fort Howard Schools.

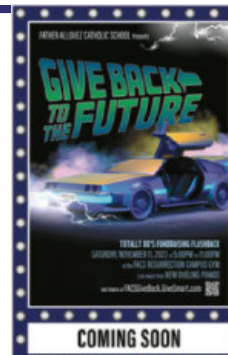

Family and friends are welcome to come and share a great feast, friendly conversation and a meal you don't have to clean up after! What could be more fun?!

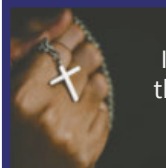
Tickets are \$20 for adults and \$10 for children 10 years and younger. Seatings are at 5:15 & 6:15 PM.
