Peace Be With You!

Over my years in ministry, I have encountered many situations of panic and disorientation along the way. I can list a few on my own journey. My experience and training have always led me back to one particular response that is satisfying and growth-filled for the situation. It is quite



simple...'peace be with you.' How simple and yet so profound. Peace be with you! This phrase reminds us of the firm foundation of our past life, that we are still able to breathe today and whatever comes our way tomorrow is already taken care of for us. What is your panic today? Peace be with you!

In three separate moments the Risen Jesus appears to the disciples, men and women alike, and states, "Peace be with you." In our gospel, we can see the early Christian community in a state of panic and deep fear. They had nowhere to go as their mission just brutally died on a cross. Within the suffering of that panic. Jesus reassures them that there is peace in their midst. Tomorrow is taken care of for them. Lam here!

I love Thomas. Not because I take this Thomas as my namesake but because this Thomas is definitely uncertain of himself. Thomas knew that he needed proof. He was not going to make a rash decision without some thought and reflection. If he signed on to this mission of Jesus, he knew the costs and challenges even unto death. Thomas had to make sure before he proclaimed Jesus as "My Lord and my God!" In his soul-searching Thomas could only arrive at one decision as no other way of life would satisfy his desires and needs. It was Jesus' way or no way. This is a good description of my vocational path in life. I am all in!

This Easter season invites us to ponder, reflect and pray about our spiritual path. Is Jesus our Lord and our God? Do we follow Jesus' call to love all God's people all the time? Or are we lukewarm in our approach to God's call and mission. Don't panic and stress, we have 50 days of Easter to discern this call before Pentecost!

All women are invited and encouraged to bring friends, neighbors, and relatives for a lovely day featuring a lunch with raffle baskets and door prizes.


