#### **Vocation to Imitate Christ**

The Gospel reading where Jesus is basically rejected in his hometown is my classic story from my ordination day. After communion, Bishop Maida would call up the newly ordained and tell them their first assignment as Associate Pastor. Bishop stated to me that I would be going to Little Chute - my hometown. My stunned expression showed through clearly as he repeated it a couple of times, saying how wonderful Little Chute would be to serve. He apologized after Mass, sending me instead to Appleton where only my brother was a parishioner.

For some reason, it is challenging to be 'as Christ' in our families and hometown settings. Yet Jesus said, 'Stop murmuring among yourselves.' No matter where we are in life, Jesus is the living bread and we are all asked to partake and share new life with others. Our vocation to the priesthood, religious, married, or single life is how we are called to live out our faith. In our first reading, Elijah is frustrated and wants out. He said 'take my life.' Be careful what you pray for! God went to him and told him to eat and drink because his journey would be long. Elijah then became the most profound prophet in the history of Israel.

'Take my life' is a call to imitate Christ in such a way that our lives are turned over to God. Trusting in God's ways leads us to make decisions in our lives that are no longer about ourselves but now intertwined with God's message of faith and hope.

What is your vocation? What is God calling you to do and be in our world today? How do you resist this tugging of your heart especially within your own family and friends?






