May we faithfully serve & love God, celebrate each other's work & contribution, and welcome everyone who joins the journey, whenever that may be!

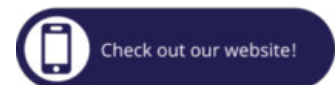

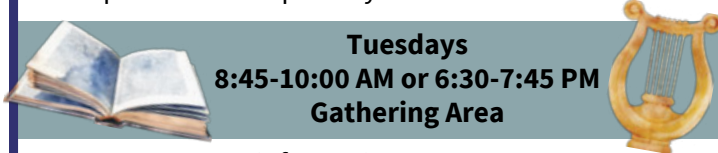

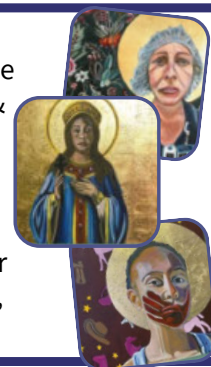
Art Exhibit on Display at Resurrection
