A Love Story That Started With Friendship

When I was 16, my cousin Bryan and I rode our motorcycles to A&W for an ice cream cone following a hard-fought football game we had just played. While enjoying a cone, we glanced outside and saw two girls holding a small sign in their car window that said, "you're cute." We looked at each other and within seconds were standing at the car meeting new friends. That was the start of a long relationship between JoDee and I. We dated 6 years, were engaged for 2 years and celebrated 40 years of marriage last month.

Reflecting on that first encounter with JoDee, only a year later, when I was 17, I had another relationship to consider. I was approaching the starting line of making a commitment to the Catholic Church through the Sacrament of Confirmation. It was much like the 8 year journey of dating JoDee which began with small talk, then taking risk to introduce her to my closest friends and then my family. Over 8 years we grew stronger in our relationship, 1 day at a time, one conversation at a time.

JoDee was brought up in the United Church of Christ Faith. Prior to our engagement we made a commitment to one another that once married, we wanted our children to have parents of the same faith. JoDee went through the OCIA – Order of Christian Initiation of Adults and was confirmed Catholic prior to our twins being born.

As I reflect on love stories, they begin with relationships. I see similarities between a friendship that leads to marriage and a friendship that can lead to a commitment to being Catholic.
