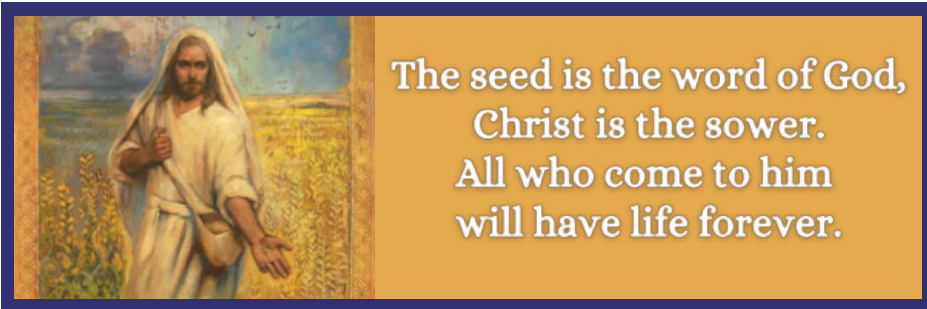

60 Years of Planting Seeds

Resurrection Parish was founded on September 13, 1963. Fr. William Spalding was the founding pastor. We are grateful to St. Matthew Parish, our mother parish, for sending us off to build a new parish. Resurrection Parish comprises the southern end of what had been St. Matthews parish boundaries. Jesus planted many seeds of faith and hope within the founding families of our parish.



As our parish began to grow there were many people who were deeply faith filled and gifted in many ways to keep Resurrection Parish healthy and strong in faith. It became clear early on that our mission would not be confined within the parish boundaries set by the diocese. There were so many resourceful people, including Vince Lombardi, who had influence in many other structures of the Green Bay area. From the Packers to hospitals, from educational opportunities to business adventures, Resurrection Parish's vision had great reach and influence. All were sent forth from the community celebration of Eucharist to love and serve others, especially to bring hope and justice to the downtrodden.

These are the seeds of faith we hold dear to us today. This same Spirit of being missionary disciples is what drives us today to 'Love all God's people all the time.' Jesus knew that we hold the essence of all creation in our hearts and souls. He entrusted that seed of faith to be nurtured from one generation to another. We continue to plant those seeds of faith today.

St. Paul this weekend speaks of all creation 'groaning in labor pains.' This is a good angst. This is the deep calling of God's voice that brings us to continually bring painful experiences within ourselves and in others' lives to the light of day. What began 60 years ago, listening, sharing faith stories, offering a simple cup of cold water and forming ourselves in the Gospel of Jesus Christ is still what brings a renewed sense of hope to this community of faith named Resurrection Parish.

This Spirit will continue to allow our parish to grow and produce much fruit well into the future. Thank you for being a part of this great mysterious work of God!

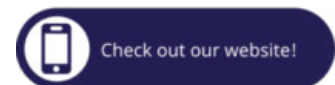

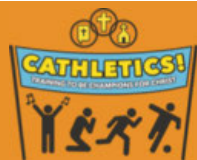
