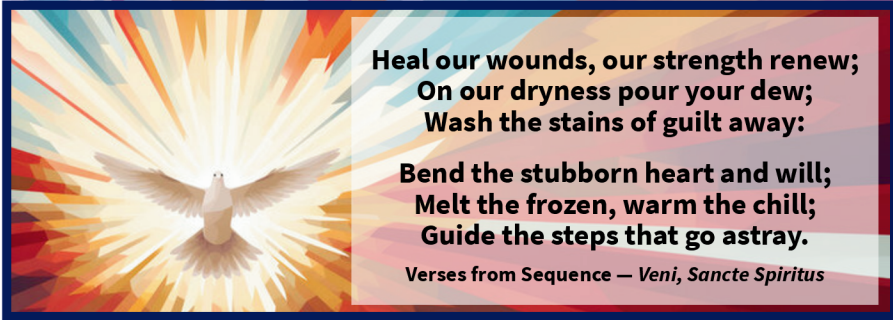

Remembering

If memory is such a powerful tool (and it is), then why does it seem to misfire as we get older? And, to make it more interesting, what most often misfires is an event that just happened — not something from 40 years ago.

Whatever the mysteries of individual memory, it is collective memory we look to this weekend. Memorial Day is a day of remembrance, praise and honoring those who have died in the line of duty — usually in combat. It was begun as Decoration Day in 1868, three years after the Union Armies had won our Civil War. There is and should be a lot of remembering today.

Do we remember being taught goodness, being taught to tell the truth and not to be mean or cruel to others? Hopefully, somewhere along the line, these and other virtues were instilled in us by parents, teachers, or influencers who hoped that such things would equip us to make our way through a secular world. We need to remember these lessons and apply them in our lives today. More than ever, we need to stand up for the minority person, the outcast or immigrant, and the oppressed of this world. This is no mystery or heresy. It is what Our Lord taught us 2,000 years ago in his parable of the Good Samaritan.

After all, what did the vast majority of the people who died for our country in the line of duty — the ones we remember today — die for? Was it for the medals or the glory? Or was it because this country has always stood up for freedom for all. It has always been supported in that endeavor by the little guy — the average Jane and Joe who are the real people who helped build our way of life over 250 years. The iconic Statue of Liberty inscription says it best: *“Give me your tired, your poor, your huddled masses yearning to breathe free . . . send these, the homeless, tempest-tossed to me, I lift my lamp beside the golden door.”*
