Rejoice with Jerusalem! Rejoice with the United States!

These are challenging times to rejoice, especially on the 4th of July. Gas prices, inflation, no end in sight for the war in Ukraine and other wars in our world, where will our economy go in the near future, and the overturning of Roe vs. Wade, all keep us on the edge of unease as we try to live life today with some kind of normalcy. My favorite expression applies here, 'live the new normal'...again!



In our first reading, Jerusalem has fallen again to outsiders who have invaded and dispersed the Jews. This seems to have been a regular occurrence in their history. Isaiah is sending a message of hope even though they have not regained their normalcy back in Jerusalem. Even though they are still in exile, REJOICE! Even though they do not have their temple to worship in, REJOICE!! Even though they feel God has abandoned them, REJOICE!!!

This was challenging for them as it is for us today. How did they find hope when all looked lost? They held on to their faithfulness in God's love and providence. At the moment, their treasure was in heaven more than on earth but they did not give up. There was hope, they worked hard to build the kingdom of God here on earth and then God did the rest. Not too long ago we prayed with and for the Holy Spirit to fill us with hope and wisdom.

Jesus similarly cautioned his disciples with words that kept them from getting too comfortable where ever they ended up that day. It will be difficult... 'Lambs among wolves'...you won't need much to sustain yourselves... 'no money bag, no sack, no sandals'...if you are not welcomed... 'shake the dust off of your feet'. Jesus knew the kingdom of God would take time to create and be sustained here upon this earth. So don't hang on to the negative 'dust', wash your feet and move on.

This is such great wisdom for us today. We need to stay faithful to what God is calling us to do here and now. We need to always lead with love and hope no matter who we speak with or what is happening around us. Only this will sustain us as we continue to rejoice knowing that this is about God's plan for us and the world at large --- not our plan for God's creation.

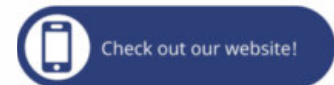
