



A Smelly Mess

The early Church, as we saw with Mary Magdala and the other disciples, could easily be described as a mess. Pentecost happened and they had to scramble for some human structure to appreciate and preserve the moment. With human beings, there is always an ego and status struggle to determine who ends up on top of the mound. It's what we do. We create chaos more than harmony.



The gift we have as Church and society is the capacity to live within the chaos that offers order and harmony. What Jesus taught us is that we are not the author of harmony. Harmony and unity are innate within us and dwell within creation as we know it. We may tilt the balance of nature but nature has always righted itself with or without us.

Pope Francis addressed priests on Holy Thursday, and by extension each of us through our baptism, with words that speak of the Good Shepherd: "The priest (all baptized) who seldom goes out of himself ... misses out on the best of our people, on what can stir the depths of his priestly heart... This is precisely the reason why some priests grow dissatisfied, lose heart and become in a sense collectors of antiquities or novelties — instead of being shepherds living with 'the smell of the sheep.' This is what I am asking you — be shepherds with the smell of sheep."

We all miss out on what life and salvation offer us when we remain isolated and insulated from the messiness of human life. Escaping the chaotic life here on earth only keeps us from evolving and transforming into the Body of Christ God intends for us and all of creation. Either we can 'smell like sheep' or live outside of the pasture. It's a daily choice and what Resurrection Parish is called to do as we 'Love all God's People All The Time.'
