Wrath and Anger Are Hateful Things!

It is always amazing to me that we create selfish, self-serving life patterns we normalize in our own 'inner worlds' and find them very comfortable within which to live. We can go about our normal business without understanding our 'life patterns' can be very hurtful to others. I have heard many comments from myself and others stating, "If I had only known." Yet often it was too late.



Our readings today speak of these conscious or unconscious thought patterns that can be filled with wrath, anger, vengeance and wickedness. I have to say we are all guilty and responsible for these responses whether we are aware of them or not. Oftentimes those around us or society at large legitimizes these responses. We often speak and act from within a mob mentality.

Yahweh, from our first reading; Paul, from our second reading; and Jesus from our gospel all understand how difficult it is to change these quick responses that are so hurtful to others and ourselves.

When I was younger, my family was very sarcastic and negative in nature as we would tease each other. It got so bad some of us were avoiding family gatherings. We finally talked about it and decided to use the code word 'negative' if anyone felt a comment was hurtful, wrathful, vengeful or wicked. It took a few years before we heard the word 'negative' tossed out there as frequently. Our behaviors are difficult to change! I believe in our case it was a moment of grace when we all collectively realized we could change this hurtful behavior.

Jesus' life mission was to bring out the Spirit of hope and truth in all those he met. He connected the average person's heart and soul into the larger goodness of Divine Love. This love is always present and yet we easily forget or consciously deny it in order for us to stay within our own selfish power. Life choices are not easy and yet they can transform the world in which we live.

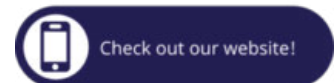
