


Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 22 & 23, 2023



Dandelions: Weeds or Not?

During my eight years of teaching, I received many bouquets of dandelions. Every spring, without fail, at least one student would return from recess holding a bouquet of dandelions. They would joyfully hand me the bouquet and say they picked them for me.



It was at the moment I was presented with a yellow bouquet from a smiling student in which I had to make a choice. I could accept the bouquet and appreciate the time and effort it took this student to stop playing and gather this gift for me or I could reject the gesture, tell the student not to pick weeds, and throw them away.

My students didn't know they were giving me a bunch of what some refer to as weeds. They had not learned about weeds or unwanted plants. To them, the dandelions were flowers they could give as a gift, not a plant some people find undesirable or clashes with personal preferences.

The parable Jesus tells in this weekend's gospel about the weeds growing among the wheat makes it clear we are not called to be the weeders of the kingdom. He teaches us we are not to root out anyone who does not fit or live how we believe is right. God can see where the weeds are growing. He knows the good seeds will take root and grow strong. We are to be patient and to continue to grow in the kingdom, proclaiming the good news of the gospel. We hope and trust in the weeds growing into golden wheat.

Only God can make a judgement between the weeds and the wheat. He is the one who will decide who is "in" and who is "out." It is not our job to remove the undesirable or the ones who conflict with our ideal. What if someone had come through to destroy the dandelions on the playground? What if my students were taught dandelions are unwelcomed? A beautiful moment between a student and teacher would have been lost.

Finally, as food for thought: although they have a bad reputation, dandelions have many nutritional and medical benefits. Maybe they're not as big of a weed as some believe. Maybe God will surprise us in what and who he deems are the weeds in our world.
